MINUTES

I. Quorum

1.1. The presence of a quorum was confirmed.

2. 2012 Minutes

2.1. Neil summarised the fees and finances and the 2012 AGM minutes were approved.

3. Honorary Secretary's report

- 3.1. M1, M2 and M3 all recorded highest league positions/points on record. M4 had a difficult start but finished with 5 wins and 1 draw. M3s have been provisionally promoted to Div 4NW from 3rd place in Div 5NW due to reshuffle in higher divisions.
- 3.2. L1 consolidated with mid-table finish in Cambs Prem and 2nd highest points tally at this level. L2s were affected by loss of players from last season and lack of consistent availability but finished with a 4-2 win over Cambridge City.

- 3.3. Large number of new player enquiries, particularly ladies, but not carried through into availability figures. Subs paid increased from 65 to 68 for men, static at 29 for ladies.
- 3.4. Men's Playing Committee have decided to enter an M5s team into Div 6NW(S) next season, mainly due to large number in M4s. Player numbers just about support this but double-up/lean squads may be required.
- 3.5. The Cambs Ladies League has voted to dissolve and join the East Women's League for 2013/14, as have the Lincolnshire Ladies League. Divisons will be reorganised from 1 Lincs and 3 Cambs divisions into 2 nothern and 2 southern divisions. Had hoped that this would mean increase in division size but some clubs Rutland, Oundle have withdrawn so divisions will remain only 9 teams but with no cup competitions. Suggested that teams could play each other 3 times to increase fixtures Kylie to propose this to the EWL.

4. Honorary Treasurer's reports and approval of accounts

- 4.1. Ladies' section
 - 4.1.1. George was absent but submitted a financial report for 2012/13. The Ladies' section made a small loss, with income of £6244.05 against expenditure of £6,538.35. The end of season bank balance was £2,172.80.
 - 4.1.2. Kit expenditure was down from last season by £600+ and Pay and Play income had also increased. Match fees were down by £200 and training and equipment costs up by the same. 53 players were used over the season, of whom 29 paid subs
 - 4.1.3. Forecast is for a £430 loss for next season. This sustainable for the time being and no action is recommended at this point. If a few more players are converted into full subs-paying members, this could easily change to a break even.

4.2. <u>Men's Section</u>

- 4.2.1. George was absent but submitted a financial report for 2012/13. The Men's section had income of £18,403.52 against expenditure of £14,674.65 a surplus of £3,728.87. The end of season bank balance was £7,998.31.
- 4.2.2. Kit expenditure was down by £1,000 on last season, subs income had increased by the same and match fees by £500. Pay and Play income was also up and pitch hire costs slightly down. 92 players featured for the club and 68 paid subs.
- 4.2.3. Current prediction is for an £1,980 surplus for next season. This will aid in rebuilding club funds after several years of steady losses. A £1,000 surplus allows for periodic one-off costs such as replacing keeping kit or new sets of shirts. Recommend to leave fees at current levels for now and consider spending more on kit (e.g. new keeping kit).

5. Subscriptions and Match Fees for 2012/13:

- 5.1. The Men's fees were maintained at £9 (£4.50 unwaged) and subs at £100 (£40).
- 5.2. The Ladies' fees were maintained at £8 (£4) and subs at £100 (£40).

6. Election of Officers:

- 6.1. Chairman John Greaves was nominated and elected unanimously.
