## 4. Highlights of Reports

Fixture Secretary: Colin Warboys reported that most fixtures had worked out well again, and next

season's fixtures were largely arranged. He has been trying to arrange stronger opposition for the Veterans matches next season - they have been getting bored

winning.

Treasurer: Kevin Pride reported that the club had made loss of approximately £100 this season

(compared with a profit of £725 last year). The poor financial performance was

largely due to:

• a one-off payment of approximately £400 to the H.A.

• increased pitch hire costs (Veterans playing at St Catherines)

• poor collection of match fees and subscriptions from the 1sts and 2nds

1<sup>st</sup> XI: Ken Sharpe reported on a good effort this season, finishing 7<sup>th</sup> in the hew higher

division, and deserving to be even higher. Top scorer was 'Trevor Collingwood' (even though he emigrated at Christmas) and Player of the Year = Owen Howell.

2<sup>nd</sup> XI: Peter Carey reported that the 2nds got off to a slow start, largely due to match

fitness (or lack of), and by Christmas they were 2<sup>nd</sup> from bottom. However, superhuman efforts in the second half of the season moved them up the table out of the relegation zone. Player of the Year = Andy Lewis, for all the hard effort put in.

Wrinklies: Yet another 'best season ever' for Mike Gronow's Veterans side. Won 19, drew 3,

lost 2 (both by 1-0). Player of the Year = Peter Kemp, but great performances too from 'Beefy' Bettison, 'Dyno' Dale, 'Plantpot' Seymour and Roger-the-dodger.
